Due Dates:

1 st Quarter Due: September 15, 2016	Billing Period for 07/01/16 to 09/30/16
2 nd Quarter Due: November 15, 2016	Billing Period for 10/01/16 to 12/31/16
3 rd Quarter Due: February 15, 2017	Billing Period for 01/01/17 to 03/31/17
4 th Quarter Due: May 15, 2017	Billing Period for 04/01/17 to 06/30/17

*If not paid on or before the due date, interest of 1% per month will be charged from the due date. On any amount unpaid after May 15, 2017 an 8% penalty will be added along with interest. The property is considered delinquent at this time, and subject to tax sale.

2016 Utility Bill Due Dates

August 15, 2016	Billing Period for 04/01/16 to 06/30/16 - Meter readings from mid June to mid Sept
November 15, 2016	Billing Period for 07/01/16 to 09/30/16 - Meter readings mid Sept to mid Dec
February 15, 2017	Billing Period for 10/01/16 to 12/31/16 - Meter readings for mid Dec to mid March
May 15, 2017	Billing Period for 01/01/17 to 03/31/17 - Meter readings for Mid March to Mid June

*If not paid on or before the due date, a penalty of 8% will be assessed. Additionally, interest will be charged at the rate of 1% per month.

Payment Policy

Payments for Real Estate Taxes, Personal Property Taxes and Utilities can be made in person at the Treasurer's Office. Office hours are 8:30 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday thru Friday.

Payments can be made in cash and personal check at the counter. An official US postmark with the due date will be considered as an on time payment. No third party checks will be accepted.

Credit / Debit Cards:

Credit and Debit card payments can be made online at www.brattleboro.org. Click on "bill pay" at the bottom of the homepage. There is a fee for this service. Payments will be considered on time if the transaction is dated on the due date. We cannot accept credit / debit card payments at the office counter or by telephone.

Direct Debit Program:

The Town of Brattleboro offers the Direct Debit Program for tax and utility payments. Forms are available in the Treasurer's Office or online at www.brattleboro.org. Click on "Departments" on the homepage and click on "Treasurer's Office". There is no fee for this service.

Electronic Bank Checks:

Electronic Bank Checks must be received in the office by 5:00 PM on the due date. Checks dated for the due date, but received after the due date will not be considered an on time payment. Please check with your bank for payment schedule.

Payments slipped in the mail slot after hours on the due date will not be considered on time.
