Whereas the arts are a major motivator attracting tourists for meals and lodgings in our area.

And whereas public art enhances the value and usefulness of public buildings and other public property.

Be it resolved that as of fiscal year 2013 (or whatever starts with the next budget)
1% of all capital budgets for buildings, parks, bridges and other public investments
and 10% of the Town's receipts from the 1% local option rooms and meals tax

Will be deposited into a Public Art Fund to be maintained and administered by the Town Arts Committee (TAC).

Expenditures from this fund will be matched 50% from other sources (private, foundation, in-kind)

Expenditures from this fund will adhere to the Public Arts Policy approved by the Select Board

Expenditures from this fund up to \$1,000 (net) will require only approval of TAC

Expenditures from this fund over \$1,000 (net) will require approval of the Select Board.
