1. Adjust meeting agenda – Crosby Gannet Grant added to line #7, Bike Safety Day added to line #10
2. Approve meeting notes from Feb. 25, 2016 - approved
3. Public Participation - none
4. Update on Act 250 status – Marquise & Morano is still working on the site plans, no further specifics on their progress
5. Update on Art Place America Grant - BASIC has applied to the ArtPlace America Grant. Footage for a video to accompany the application was created by Liz McLoughlin and Linda Whelihan. The footage was then put together into a video by Andrew Clark. The purpose of the video was to specify how BASIC will incorporate art into the design of the park. 6. Update on You Caring Video –Shane from Mondo Media has produced a rough cut of the video to be used on a You Caring site. The final video will be available for BASIC to view at the next meeting. The You Caring site will be created by BASIC once the Act 250 Permit has been finalized.
7. Crosby Gannet Grant – BASIC is unable to apply for the Crosby Gannet Grant at this point because the Dog Park committee has already applied. The Park & Rec. Dept. can't have two of their committees competing for the same grant. BASIC can apply at the next application deadline in the fall.
8. Update on March Gallery Walk – Joe III states there was a lot of positive feedback at the March Gallery Walk. Some small donations were taken in. BASIC will not have a table set up for April but will plan on getting permits in place for the May Gallery Walk
