

Voters may request an early ballot until 5 p.m. the day before an election. A voter may.....

1. vote in person in the town clerk's office.
2. take their ballot home. A voter may not take a ballot for another but may request that a ballot be mailed by the clerk's office to another voter.
3. request that the town clerk's office mail a ballot to them.
4. have two justices of the peace deliver their ballot and return it if they are housebound.

In order to be counted, all early ballots must be returned no later than the close of polls on election day.

The Polls are open on election day from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

There is free voter parking in back of the Municipal Center.

There is an elevator at ground level just inside the back door of the Municipal Center to the left.

BRATTLEBORO **ELECTION/TOWN MEETING** **POLICIES**



For Campaigners, Pollsters,
and Special Interest Groups.



Political signs are not to be placed *on* the walls of the Municipal building or *in* the ground on the property. All signs must be removed from the property by 8:00 p.m. on election night.

Campaigning or electioneering outside is allowed in two specific areas only.

- 1.) **In the back of the Municipal Center** on the south side of the back doors in the area drawn out in chalk on the pavement (near the bicycle rack). Supporters may not gather on the north side of the entrance as that area is reserved for handi-capped parking.
- 2.) **In the front of the building** on the south side on the grassy area under the apple tree.

No campaigners shall stand in the walkways. No one may impede voters from entering or exiting the building or parking areas.

IF complaints are received due to aggressive or inappropriate behavior, you may be requested to leave the premises.

No campaigning/electioneering or discussion of the election is to take place inside the building.

No visible campaign materials including apparel, signs, buttons, leaflets, or any other election materials are permitted inside the building, unless out of sight.

Special interest groups or pollsters may not set up or occupy space inside the building per order of the Brattleboro Fire Department.

Poll watchers must report to the town clerk for instructions.

Parking in the Municipal lot is limited. Please seek parking elsewhere.
