RE: Appointment of Selectboard Member to Hazard Mitigation Committee

Recommendation: Appoint a Selectboard member to the Hazard Mitigation Committee for a term ending June 20, 2021.

At the August 18, 2020 meeting, the Selectboard voted to expand the Hazard Mitigation Committee. The expanded committee includes a 1-year term for a Selectboard member.

The Hazard Mitigation Committee oversees the drafting and updating of the Town's Hazard Mitigation Plan. The current plan expires in 2021 so the committee is being brought together to oversee the process of updating and renewing the Plan.

The purpose of a Hazard Mitigation Plan is to identify hazards facing the town and to develop strategies to begin reducing risks from those hazards. The Hazard Mitigation Committee members will help set goals and priorities for future mitigation actions, advise on public outreach activities, and make sure that the feedback is incorporated into the resulting action plan.

The Committee will meet for a minimum of four publicly warned meetings over the course of four months. All Committee meetings held in 2020 will be held via GoToMeeting.
