Hello,

My name is Kelsey Rice. I am writing to express interest in being considered to serve on the citizens committee to examine community safety. I will start off by giving you some background on the Brattleboro law enforcement and criminal justice system involvement in the most vulnerable aspect of my life.

I am a survivor of intimate partner violence. I have an active Relief From Abuse Order. In September of 2018 my ex partner (father of my child) was charged with domestic assault and interference with access to emergency services (my baby was in my arms and my older two children in the next room). In April of 2019 he was convicted of both charges along with several violations of conditions of release for continuing to contact me while awaiting his conviction. In July of 2019 I reported my abuser to his parole officer and the Brattleboro Police Department for violating the RFA. My ex partner was finally convicted of violating the RFA in January 2020. When the pandemic hit, he ran to Alaska. It was not discovered by probation and parole until I filed to extend my RFA. He was extradited back to Vermont and is now incarcerated awaiting a conviction for again violating the RFA.

I am a 37 year old white woman born into socioeconomic privilege. I have deeply rooted, life long community ties in the Brattleboro community. My experience with law enforcement while trying to fight my way out of domestic violence (Brattleboro PD, VT State Police, Brattleboro and Springfield VT. probation and parole, Claremont and Keene NH. probation and parole), quite honestly exacerbated the pain and emotional trauma. My most private hell became very public state wide due to mistakes made by our local law enforcement. My children experienced shame at school, and I experienced discrimination in my workplace from my employer because of it (not my current employer). I was dismissed and lied to by Brattleboro PD officers and in doing so; they unintentionally put me in an extremely dangerous situation for months on end. The situation was only resolved because I finally reached out to the Windham county state attorneys office. I would love the opportunity to share my story with all of its twists in turns. In summary, I had to demand that the Brattleboro PD uphold a court order instructing them to arrest my abuser. The process of fighting the police for my safety when seeking refuge from violence, while simultaneously publicly shamed for being a survivor, was a remarkable journey. Surprisingly, I am grateful for it. It helped me to rediscover my voice and develop an appreciation for my stubborn resilience. My anonymity as a DV survivor was taken from me by law enforcement. The pre conceived notion I once held (in my white privilege existence); in the darkest of times I could rely on the police to serve and protect me with integrity, respect and professionalism, was demolished. My goal is to use my name, story and privilege to help dismantle the prejudice surrounding DV. Abusers rely upon societies collective "look the other way and don't get involved approach". I am prepared to make some respectful, carefully considered noise!!

My professional background is in social work and mental health. I currently work for Easterseals VT. Brattleboro as a Family Engagement Specialist. I serve children in DCF custody by working with their parents. My work involves coaching both victims and perpetrators of domestic violence. I also facilitate family safety planning meetings, care coordination services for front end DCF investigations with the intention of preventing children from going into custody, as well as other Easterseals VT child and family services. In my current role and in other positions I have held in the past, I support and advocate for men and women facing homelessness, intimate partner violence, substance use and mental health disorders, generational poverty, generational trauma, and discrimination from every direction simply for being part of a vulnerable population.

I am a single mother working full time, receiving EBT food benefits, fuel assistance, child care subsidy and Medicaid health insurance for my three children. I find great purpose in the work I do as I have the opportunity to channel my lived experience into supporting those less privileged in our community. I was blessed with resiliency factors that so many of our suffering community members were not. I am a skilled speaker and mediator. I am a stubborn advocate that is respected for seeking collaboration while standing up to injustice. I have natural supports in this community who ensured I would never have to consider homelessness or how to feed my children when I lost my job and home as a result of the abuse I endured.

Throughout my journey navigating the criminal justice system as a victim of domestic violence, I could not ignore the shocking reality that if this is the experience for a woman who knows how to use her voice (in an emotionally regulated, professional manner under extreme distress) and understands the complexities of social systems; what does it look like for the countless women that were not born into privilege?!

Please know my intention is simply to offer my voice and first hand experience with the aim of expanding understanding and hopefully inspiring collaboration. I do not wish to demonize the police. I wish to help support our law enforcement and community partners to better serve survivors of DV and all vulnerable peoples in need.

In January 2020, I met with Chief Fitzgerald and shared with him my story and the role BPD played in it. Chief Fitzgerald was so impressed with my perspective and willingness to be transparent about not only the terror survivors of DV live through, how his department failed to serve and protect me; but also speak openly about actions I took along the way (just as so many survivors do), that perpetuate the as Chief Fitzgerald described it "jaded" mentality and systemic discrimination police officers and the criminal justice system at large operate from, even if unknowingly. The Chief invited me to address his officers. In February 2020, I stood in front of a room full of BPD officers, the BPD social worker, two Windham County states attorneys (one being the Windham County AG), Windham County states attorney victims advocate Kati Sell-Knapp and Shari an advocate from the Women's Freedom Center. I spoke for an hour and a half!

That same week Sarah Robinson Deputy Director for the Vermont Network Against Domestic and Sexual Violence asked me to testify in Montpelier in support of H.610 which is a bill that would close the Charleston Loop Hole, and enable law enforcement to confiscate all fire arms at the time of temporary RFA orders being served. This bill is a step towards more effectively protecting survivors of DV seeking safety. A large percentage of Vermont's gun enthusiasts are opposed to this bill. I testified in Montpelier in a court room full of orange wearing angry gun owners. I spoke in vivid detail about the experience of seeking an RFA.

Sarah Robinson connected me with Vermont State Police Major Ingrid Jonas who commands the Support Services Division and oversees the Office of Fair and Impartial Policing and Community Affairs. Last month I met with Major Jonas and Kathryn Brayton VT. State police Director of Victim Services and member of VSP domestic violence task force. I shared my story specifically focused on Vermont State Police and the Brattleboro Police Department. Major Jonas and Kathryn Brayton were so impressed with my willingness to speak and sadden by my story, that they intend to pull me into the DV training for VT. State police. Of course like everything involved in police policy and reform it could take some time before I am invited to be involved in some capacity. It is nevertheless exciting to potentially have the opportunity to again speak on behalf of the DV survivors in our Vermont communities that are less privileged.

I also recently had a zoom meeting with Legislator Emilie Kornheiser to share my story, again centered around the need for more extensive law enforcement training and oversight; along with other gaps in effectively protecting survivors during the most dangerous period of time which is when we are trying to leave.

I have been persistent on my quest to lend my voice in service to both less privileged survivors as well as our law enforcement officers. I truly believe I earned a fair amount of respect from the BPD. I saw genuine empathy in those officers eyes, heads shaking in shame, and at times laughter. I highlighted the positive experiences I have had with law enforcement officers as a survivor, which truly aided in my recovery. I intend to continue to honor those that do the work well as well as those that are seeking to expand their understanding of how to do better by our community.

That is a long winded email! I decided to offer you some background as to why I am asking for your consideration, before knowing what the actual application process is because I recently moved to Saxtons River. I still work in Brattleboro as I described in detail. It is my hope that based upon my lived experience, and already proven desire to be of service to the Brattleboro community, you will consider me despite no longer being a resident. I have been waiting for the select board to finalize the plan to form the committee prior to reaching out. I have been doing this advocacy work without asking for any sort of compensation. I simply have a desire to serve. I would be requesting your consideration without the possibility of compensation, and whatever the compensation may be, I am eager to serve.

*I think re-imagining community safety in a framework outside of policing and incarceration has a good chance of making a small, local dent in the biggest, most intractable problems of American society: systematic racism, incarceration, de-facto slavery, addiction, all of it. I think this is a real chance to make something new. I'm a white, transgender business owner living with mental illness, who comes from that particular liberal background of mixed privilege and neglect. I have felt unsafe in Brattleboro multiple times before, in ways that I could not address to the police or to anyone who I thought could change it: when a well-dressed white woman shouted at me outside a church for looking too gay on Easter; when a neighbor took to facebook and threatened to bring a gun to my workplace to "explain" an argument about why transgender people are threats to society; when my business landlord's property manager came to our office door and asked us to sign a form approving a restraining order to keep someone "crazy" and "off his meds" from entering the building; when I happened to glance down Green Street one sunny morning and saw a dozen men in black unmarked body armor with semi-automatic rifles storming down the sidewalk in a disorganized mob. (I learned later that this was probably a state-sanctioned "drug raid". This knowledge made it worse.) My skills are in organization. I take good notes, I keep conversations on topic, I stick to goals. I'm also decently acquainted with a few ways that institutional privilege works in Brattleboro specifically, having now run a business here, shopped for office space, talked with many landlords and property owners and bankers and lenders and business organizations, and been told multiple times that I'm the "right sort" of candidate they're looking for. Because I'm white, my name is known, I can write a business plan, and my diagnoses have not yet landed me in the Retreat, people with money in this town offer to lend me some. My thinking on community safety tends to come from an economic perspective: who has the money, who protects it, where does it go. Which of our neighbors are owners, and who is the commodity? And how do we take that relationship apart?*

There's a deep and ongoing deference for farmers, potters, bakers, machinists, artists, photographers: people who carry on the old and now-gutted maker traditions of Estey Organ and the Cotton Mill and the Book Press. (Though healthcare is a huge part of our town's current economy, widespread medically-induced addiction, human rights abuses in mental healthcare facilities, and the ongoing American healthcare crisis have all combined to keep Brattleboro from considering itself a hospital town, or a healthcare town.) But. That means Brattleboro is a town that clings to its pre-globalization past, one that romanticizes an 1800s-era economy that was fueled by slavery and*

international looting. There's a "cottagecore" aspect to the town aesthetic, a cozy fantasy (for the white folks who can afford it) that the worst of modern American problems can't reach us in our tucked-away Vermont enclave. Fortunately, the theater, art, youth organizing, and LGBTQ+ groups in town are building new things all the time. Some of them even stick.

I have been a District 3 Representative Town Meeting member for the last two years. I've been on the leadership team of the Brattleboro Node of 350VT, a local climate justice organization, for two years. A year-and-a-half ago, I co-founded the Men's Auxiliary, a group of men working in the aftermath of Brett Kavanaugh's confirmation to confront toxic masculinity, misogyny and homophobia in solidarity with groups such as the Womens' Freedom Center, Planned Parenthood and Out in the Open. During the beginning of the pandemic, I worked with Brattleboro Area Mutual Aid.

**Why are you interested in this position and what particular skills would you bring to the organization?**

Community Safety Review Committee: I'm interested in joining this committee because I have seen first hand in every place that I have lived as an adult (California; Cairo, Egypt; Washington, DC; and here in Brattleboro) the police used as at best a crutch and at worst a cudgel to attempt to address the worst effects of social problems after they have already occurred, rather than pro-actively building more safe, universally flourishing, and resilient communities while practicing restorative justice to address inevitable conflicts. I have personally been a victim of police abuse (and was party to a lawsuit against LAPD because of such abuse during the 2000 Democratic Convention:

<https://www.latimes.com/archives/la-xpm-2004-may-08-me-demo8-story.html>). I have spent years of my life being homeless or precariously housed, and was once roused from my bed at 2am and had my home in the woods destroyed by police. I lived in Cairo when widespread and rampant police abuse and disappearances sparked off the April 6th movement and the eventual overthrow of Hosni Mubarak, and felt the fear and tension that Cairenes experienced under the heel of police impunity. I've tried to help a friend going through a mental health crisis navigate resources here in Vermont, only to find them similarly oriented in a punitive and carceral model, with Burlington's SWAT team responding in force at one point, which was deeply unhelpful. The only personal experience I've had with police in Brattleboro when I was involved in a minor fender-bender was remarkably positive even though I was in the wrong, although it was with Sgt. Penny Witherbee, who subsequently resigned and sued the department for gender discrimination and harassment. I consider myself very fair-minded and look forward to coming to common solutions with other Brattleboro residents on this committee.

Conservation Commission: I'm interested in serving on this committee because, while I have as yet been unable to attend any meetings, I have followed the agendas and minutes and am very much interested in their work and the work of conservation generally. Recently, when a neighbor was putting up their home and surrounding land for sale, they decided to split off the land in order to reduce the price of the home. My partner and I were concerned about the wooded property getting developed and had a very hard time finding land trusts that would help us conserve the land, so we ultimately purchased the property and plan to put it in a conservation easement. This has given me some insight into conservation priorities in the area. Especially since the pandemic, I have devoted considerable time to learning more about ecological forestry and wildlife conservation, attending multiple webinars per week on the subject. I completed the VT Coverts Cooperator training two years ago. As of the Summer
