I am so incredibly proud of the BML staff, Trustees and Town personnel for their swift and positive reactions and commitment to the community during this ongoing event that has surpassed any of our imaginations. Their efforts have been heroic and creative. When we first began to realize the ramifications of the coming crisis the staff rallied to get materials to patrons until the very last minute, all the while attending to one another's safety and that of the public at large by offering "to-go service" of selections of specific titles as well as pulling together genre/age specific collections for individuals and families. Staff also realized the necessity of suspending the return of borrowed items prior to closing as we could not keep up with disinfecting and sequestering them.

As we were preparing to shutter all onsite work, we arranged for online registration to issue library cards and agreed to suspend all fees, including those for non-resident cards so that people can access online resources until we reopen. We are also going through our circulation database to extend due dates and renew cards so that patrons won't be blocked from access.. To that end, we elected to purchase digital media with some of our collection funds. We increased the number of Kanopy views for our patrons, purchased additional ebooks and downloadable audio. During the time we have been closed to the public, we have continued to seek and promote additional online educational, recreational and cultural sites for patrons. Some staff members are creating tutorial videos for art projects and library instruction that will be added to the website.

Staff has also been researching information on agencies and organizations within our local community to compile into a database to effectively connect people with the services they are seeking, which will serve is in good stead for years to come. Other staff is devoting time to our recovery effort, planning the best strategies and procedures for reopening to the public. The Youth Services staff is gathering activities and book and media lists for families and to assist with at-home schooling, and making plans for the summer learning program, with options for in person and online participation. Our phone extensions have been forwarded which allows us to help the public navigate our databases and answer complex reference questions. In other words, we are busier than ever, but missing our interpersonal interactions, which make up a large part of our service.

Community Collaboration: I continue to meet with the Community Equity Collaborative and have called in to the conversations convened by Rhianna from Groundworks to keep in touch with ways we can help the vulnerable populations in town. We were able to loan a laptop to Turning Point and two to Groundworks. Several clients are pursuing online education and skill building. We also donated several boxes of books to for kids and adults to each.

Programs: We suspended our robust programming in mid-March, but not before a First Wednesday Listening Party of Vermont storytelling, a path I hope some families are pursuing at this time. The lunchtime yoga group was going strong and the creative writing series was just beginning. We are looking at ways of continuing these online. We also hosted a community sing along, which was a fitting final program for the month.

Displays: Women's History Month gave us plenty of material for displays in the adult and children's section.

Website project: We are on hiatus as we got set up to work from home, and Matt's assistance was needed across departments for the transition.

Professional Development: Staff has been attending webinars, exploring online resources and honing their skills around technology during the shutdown. We will be better than ever upon reopening.

Trustees: The Board is in limbo. The new members have not been able to be seated as they have not been elected at RTM. The March meeting has been cancelled. Individual Trustees are spending time reading and researching library trends and issues.

Promotion: Ann Braden wrote a lovely letter to the editor of *The Reformer* expressing her gratitude for the work of Children's Librarian, Lindsay Belville, which garnered well-deserved recognition. *The Reformer* also ran a Front page story of the efforts of BML to continue serving the community through the crisis. Reference librarian Jeanne Walsh did a lovely job recommending reading and listening choices on VRP's *Vermont Edition*.

Finally, I couldn't be more grateful for the support of the public, and of the Town staff and leadership, which is a consummate combination of compassion, collegiality and commitment to community and public service.

Summary of Major Activities/Work Projects:

In the Assessment Office during the month of March We have received some Business License fees and fines from the violation notices that were sent out the end of February. There are now 10 violators on the list.

On March 26, the office of Assessment was set up with remote working laptops from refurbished inventory. Inspections of permits continue to be followed under temporary revised conditions. Exterior inspections only, followed with email/phone and mailings when necessary. Business Personal Property forms have been steadily coming in. This process is now done digitally. Documents are scanned from mailings by one person, currently the Town Assessor. From there they are circulated through "Teams". An email was sent to businesses requesting reports be sent in via email. Our department decided to extend the deadline for filing Personal Property Reports from April 20 – July 20 in following with Federal filing extensions. The Grand List (NEMRC) can be updated remotely and is current with Transfers, Personal Property calculations and ongoing permit changes.

Property Valuation and Review: Homestead Filings deadlines have been extended to July 15.

The office is in daily contact via "Teams", email and phone. We remain confident the Abstract Grand List will be lodged as scheduled May 26 with Grievance Hearings being held June 9-15.

Summary of Major Activities and Work Projects:

1. On July 2, 2019 VCDP awarded a \$300,000 grant to the Town (Brattleboro Housing Authority as sub-recipient) for the Red Clover Commons development. The Brattleboro Housing Authority's request for an extension in order to satisfy the award conditions has been approved. The Town is awaiting award conditions.
2. Mailed 268 past due tax notices and 273 past due utility notices on March 17th. Tax Sale took place on October 23, 2019. The Town was the only bidder on the former Country Kitchen building. The Town paid \$11,359.20 for the property and the owner has one year to redeem the property before the Town takes ownership of the building.
3. The Town was awarded a \$375,000 scattered site grant from VCDP on behalf of the Windham Windsor Housing Trust. The Windham Windsor Housing Trust is working to satisfy the award conditions.
4. Groundworks' \$500,000 grant application to assist with the construction of a new facility has been submitted to VCDP. The application was considered by the VCDP board at its April 4, 2019 meeting and has awarded a \$400,000 grant for the project. Brattleboro has not yet received a draft grant agreement between the Town and VCDP for the Groundworks project. The Town has committed \$50,000 to the project as a grant from Program Income funds. An additional \$100,000 appropriation from Program Income funds was approved at the July 9, 2019 Selectboard meeting.

COVID-19

At the beginning of March, as the threat of the COVID-19 global pandemic grew, we started to take precautions to ensure the safety of the staff and public and to do our best to help to flatten the curve. Crews in all divisions were divided, working separately to adhere to the advice of health care professionals suggesting social distancing and maintaining six feet of separation between people. As the concerns heightened, we had some staff members working on an on-call basis and some working remotely.

Highway Division

During the month of March, we had just a couple of small storms. Mud season hasn't created very many difficulties since March was a fairly windy month. Crews have been able to start grading roads and reshaping our country drainage as well as trimming trees and cutting brush.

Maintenance Division

This month, the maintenance division has been focused on keeping our equipment operational for round the clock winter operations. We have experienced some minor break downs, but the majority of the work has been routine maintenance and crews have started to ready equipment for spring line striping.

Distribution & Storage

This is typically a very busy time for the Utilities staff as they complete meter reading, replace broken meters and respond to 'call backs' for reading issues. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, this division has had to limit contact with the public, making some of these tasks difficult to complete. Staff worked on inventory and has also been performing routine operations such as sewer maintenance, hydrant maintenance, shoveling hydrants, vehicle maintenance, and various service calls.

Water Treatment

Water Treatment staff test the water daily and are under contract to operate the Welcome Center and the Algiers water system. They continue to do all the daily maintenance of the all the water facilities and patrol the watershed. Staff has been maintaining required certification requirements by attending courses and classes on water treatment. AL Tyler has been working with staff to install a replacement soft start pump drive at the Retreat Wells.

As always, our facilities are available for public tours and we encourage awareness of our system.

Wastewater Treatment

Wastewater Treatment staff continues to perform routine Plant and pump station operations. They continue to complete all statutory testing as required by our licensure by both State and Federal agencies. The Plant continues to operate in compliance with all permitting requirements.

The sludge dryer pilot program continues and staff continues coordinate with consultants in an effort to control odors.

Administration

Typically, at this time of year, administrative staff is busy planning projects for the upcoming construction season however, given the unprecedented COVID-19 global pandemic situation, all spring projects are currently on hold.

- Forestry Projects at Pleasant Valley and Sunset Lake
- Re-design intersection at Western Ave & Williams ST
- Retaining wall failing near 431 South Main ST
- Deconstruction of salt shed at DPW has begun

- **Budget Concerns/Impacts –**

- Failing retaining wall on Williams ST, behind Vermont Country Deli
- Structural failure of salt shed at DPW

Communications

As we all know, life and work have been anything but normal during the month of March and that has been very true for the Brattleboro Fire Department. Contained in the March report is a snapshot of the different way(s) that the daily operations has changed;

- Unbelievable acts of kindness from citizens and businesses in the way of donations of food, meals, hand sanitizer, homemade masks, protective equipment, and words of support.
- All “normal” daily functions such as inspections, fire prevention, school visits, outside training classes have been canceled.
- Our buildings are “closed” to the public. Our buildings remained unlocked even in the aftermath of 9/11.
- Meetings with Rescue Inc & BMH on a weekly basis for planning & resource sharing purposes
- Twice a week conference calls with VT Emergency Management and include VT Department of Health, VT EMS, Office of the Medical Examiner, Dept of Public Safety, and others.
- Planning and protocol documents are either written, updated and/or reviewed almost daily.
- Inventory on medical PPE is done weekly so numbers can be compared, a “burn rate” can be established and a reorder date is determined.
- PPE orders to the state are slow to be filled, stock is scarce.
- Twice a week Situational Updates are completed and distributed.
- Research on best practices for the safety and health of staff
- Working with several agencies to deliver services to different groups of people
- School Meals Program is being distributed from both stations
- Housing has been secured for staff that may have to quarantine away from home due to a high-risk situation at home. Thank you SIT.

Staff

- Anxious about the unknown, prepared to handle the situation
- They “health screen” twice a shift, once when they come in to work at 8a and then again at 8p.
- Meals are being eaten in the Meeting Hall where social distancing can be maintained
- Shift Roll Calls and many trainings are done via video conferencing to keep the stations staff separated
- On coming and off going shifts do not mingle and stay separated.
- C1 is working out of Central, C2 is working out of Station 2 to minimize our contact in an effort for one of us to remain healthy.
- Office Manager is in the office a maximum of 2 days a week, the rest is work from home.
- Staff has made “grocery store and pharmacy runs” at the request of a few high risk citizens
- Participated in a “birthday parade” drive by for a local youth
- Assisted BMH with the set up of cots in a downstairs conference room that will act as overflow if needed
- Daily training sessions continue while always using social distancing. Topics have included COVID – 19 (of course), aerial ladder operations, water supply, rope rescue and many companies have offered free webinar training during this time which the shifts have taken advantage of.
- One of the shifts and the Fire Alarm Division took advantage of a warm day and light traffic conditions to run new fire alarm cable along a section of Canal St. This was a planned replacement.

Notable Incidents

- March 3 – Assisted BPD at a possible bomb incident at 232 Main St
- March 14 – Firefighters rescued a dog through the ice at 1157 Ames Hill
- March 20 – Building fire in Putney
- April 8 – Building fire in Guilford

Budget Concerns/Impacts

- A couple other line items are over budget and a few are running high but overall, the bottom line is still below the time in the fiscal year
- I have made several purchases that normally wouldn’t be made due to the COVID – 19 epidemic. Due to the VT emergency declaration it is hopeful these purchases will be covered by federal monies.

Staff news

- Full and healthy staff as of this writing – no isolations or quarantines

BFD has answered 618 calls for assistance in 2020 as of this date
208 responses in March

Summary of Major Activities/Work Projects:

Skatepark Project:

I have sent a letter of intent to Parker Construction. Due to COVID-19 the project is on hold until restrictions have been lifted by the State of Vermont and material is available to move forward with the project.

Outside Contractors:

Independent Landscape and Property Management will be starting the spring clean-up of Prospect Hill and Morningside Cemetery the week of April 13TH. This is in preparation for the mowing season.

COVID-19 Programs and Facilities:

All regularly scheduled programs have been canceled until further notice.

The spring sports season (T-Ball, Small Fry Baseball, Youth Softball, Boy's & Girl's Lacrosse, and Men's and Women's Softball) has been put on hold until further notice, however we are still taking registrations.

All Spring vacation special activities have been canceled (The Annual Easter Egg Hunt, The Annual Super Bike Day, Bowling, and The Annual Pitch, Hit, & Run Event).

The Gibson Aiken Center is closed to the public. However, Brattleboro Senior Meals is in the building daily severing over 130 Meals on Wheels Daily and another 15 plus walk up brown bag meals.

All five Playgrounds have been closed since Friday March 20, 2020 (Living Memorial Park, Crowell Lot, Elliot Street Park, South Main Street Park and Pine

Street Park) and have been posted with signage. Please see photo attached of the signage.

The Tennis/Pickleball nets have not been put up for the season. The courts will remain closed until further notice.

The Dog Park at Living Memorial Park has not opened from the winter months and will remain closed until further notice.

The Basketball Hoops have been taken down at Crowell Lot and Living Memorial Park.

Social distancing signs have been posted at all our facilities. Please see attached a copy of the sign.

All Facility rentals have been canceled through May 31, 2020.

The Recreation and Parks Department invites people to enjoy the open green spaces in the Parks where you can get some fresh air and exercise while still practicing social distancing. However, we discourage use of site amenities as it is impossible to ensure that the equipment is sanitized in between users.

Lotus Graphic has been great to work with on signage. They have been very responsive with quick turn arounds on signage request.

Programming During COVID-19:

April 1 -12 we are holding a virtual community wide Easter Egg Hunt.

On Friday April 10 we are teaming up with The Brattleboro Police Department and The Auto Mall and will be hosting "The Peter Cottontail Trail". We will be driving "Peter Cottontail" escorted Brattleboro Police around to all the neighborhoods in Brattleboro to wave and wish everyone a Happy Easter, Happy Passover, and Happy Spring.

On Wednesday and Fridays beginning April 8TH we will be offering virtual gymnastics classes via "Zoom" for ages 3 – 16. To find the Zoom link, dates and times are on our Facebook page.

Please keep an eye on our Facebook page in the coming days and weeks for upcoming activities you can enjoy at home during the stay home stay safe order.

We are continuing to take reservation for our Community Garden Plot at Stockwell Drive. Please see attached gardening guidelines during COVID-19.

Staffing:

The Assistant Director, Program Coordinator, and Administrative Assistant are all working from home and coming to the Recreation Office only when necessary. Staff is working on updating seasonal staff training manuals and daily operating procedures for the Department. In addition, they are working on plans for the upcoming summer, and virtual programming during COVID-19.

The Parks employees are working their regular schedule to address health and safety concerns within the Park and are working on spring clean-up, so we are prepared for the mowing season. In addition, they are "on call" to perform urgent maintenance services, as needed. This is being done with staff working solo and if a task must be done with two people staff is social distancing and using all protocols recommended by the CDC.






Tips for Physical Distancing In Parks


Know what 6 feet looks like. Lay measuring tape on the ground. It's the distance of a surfboard, long yoga mat or adult bike.



Do not use playgrounds or other frequently touched surfaces.




Go by yourself or those you live with.




Avoid crowded areas. If a space cannot be enjoyed safely, go home or discover a new park in your community.

COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR SAFE COMMUNITY GARDENING

These guidelines are based on current information we have on the COVID-19 virus (March 24, 2020), as well as creative thinking from community gardeners from across the country (many ideas collected thanks to dedicated garden coordinator, Hannah Treggie, from several listservs). For updates on the COVID-19 virus and precautions, visit the Center for Disease Control at <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/index.html> and the Vermont (or your state's) Department of Health at <https://www.healthvermont.gov>.



THE BASICS

01 How long can the COVID-19 virus live on surfaces?

Current research suggests the COVID-19 virus can live for up to 4 days on surfaces, longer on fabrics, depending on the surface material (plastic 72 hrs, stainless steel 48 hrs, cardboard 24 hrs - based on an article in *New England Journal of Medicine*). We don't know exactly how long it can live, but this is a good rule to follow regarding what we can and can't touch.

02 Do I need to be concerned with food safety when it comes to produce from my garden?

Always practice proper handwashing when handling food, as well as before and after eating. There is no evidence that COVID-19 is passed on through food. Thorough cooking will kill the virus. For more info go to <https://www.fda.gov/coronavirus.html>.

03 What are proper practices for keeping my hands and surfaces sanitized?

- Soap, alcohol and bleach are the best agents to kill the virus. Soap with water is VERY effective.
- Set up a handwashing station at the entrance/exits to the garden. Here's how: <https://tools4tiny.org/2020/04/building-a-handwashing-station/>.
- When washing hands with soap and water scrub for 20 seconds (Happy Birthday song twice). If soap and water are not available use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer (at least 60% alcohol). However, if hands are visibly dirty, always wash with soap and water.
- Bring sanitizing wipes and thoroughly wipe down anything that you touch that someone else might also touch. Make your own sanitizing solution by mixing 5 tablespoons (3/4 cup) of each per gallon of water. Dispose of wipes/paper towels after single use. It's good practice to wear gloves, however gloves do not replace proper sanitation procedures. The outside of your glove can still transmit diseases to yourself and others.
- Cough or sneeze into your elbow or a tissue that fully and tightly covers your mouth.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.

04 What's a safe distance for interaction with others?

- Maintain at least 6 feet between yourself and other gardeners (or far away as long handled garden tool).
- When in doubt, STAY HOME. Do not come to the garden if you are showing symptoms, someone you've been in contact with is sick, if you have health conditions, are an older adult, or a member of another high risk population.

05 How can I share these guidelines?

- Consider how people are receiving information in these days of social isolation. Share through a variety of remote methods (e-mail, text, call, social media, etc.).
- Post laminated guidelines at the entrance of the garden and throughout, especially in locations where the spread of the virus is highest.
- Take precautions and do not assume anyone else will follow these guidelines.

TOOLS & EQUIPMENT

- Inventory all areas in the garden where people commonly come into contact (i.e. spigots, hose handles, gates, tools, garden cart, etc.).
- Close off the tool storage shed and remove all community shared tools and equipment for the time being (particularly while the concern about the virus is highest).
- Ask gardeners to bring and use their own tools. If people aren't able to bring or afford their own tools, consider asking your community for tool donations for individual use. Use proper sanitizing when accepting donations.
- No tools or other personal items should be left in the garden. Gardeners need to take their tools, trash and other items home when they are done for the day.
- If any shared tools and equipment remain at the garden, be sure to use sanitizing wipes to thoroughly wipe down the handle BEFORE AND AFTER USE.
- Thoroughly wipe down the hose nozzle/spigot with sanitizing wipes BEFORE AND AFTER USE.
- Compost bins/lids should not be handled. Consider removing lids for the time being so that gardeners can directly add garden waste if lids are needed. Have a small group of volunteers maintain the compost bins while using proper sanitation techniques (as indicated above).

SCHEDULING WORK

- If possible, wait to open the garden to gardeners until early May as we work to "flatten the curve" of the virus. Stay tuned to the CDC website (listed above) for up-to-date information.
- If the garden space is small and it will be hard for gardeners to operate with proper spacing, schedule community gardeners for specific garden hours to limit numbers present in the garden at any given time. In some situations it may make sense to schedule gardeners based on the location of their plot in the garden - spreading out gardeners across the garden space.
- Avoid group work while the concern for the virus is highest. Once group work can resume, continue to use the above precautions, including: stay apart by 6 feet, bring and wear your own gloves, wash hands thoroughly, and wipe down shared surfaces.
- Assign specific tasks to gardeners at a variety of times throughout the week. One simple way of managing a schedule for shared tasks is to set up a Google Spreadsheet with a list of tasks. Have gardeners add their names, contact info and planned time for task completion next to list items.
- STAY HOME if showing any symptoms or if you've been in contact with someone who is sick.
- Encourage gardeners to STAY HOME if they are considered more vulnerable to exposure to the virus (older adults and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions). Support these gardeners by offering to plant or cultivate for them while risks remain high.

HOW TO SUPPORT THE COMMUNITY GARDENERS BY THE VULNERABLE GARDENERS THEMSELVES

- Maintain regular and timely communication with gardeners. Keep gardeners up-to-date on guidelines. Be available to respond to questions and concerns.
- Share inspiration to keep gardeners hopeful and engaged - such as garden images or quotes.
- Encourage gardener communication through an email list, Google Group or Facebook Group.
- Share remote resources for continued preparation and garden learning - such as how-to videos, free online gardening classes, and the Extension Master Gardener Hotline.
- Offer free resources from sources you trust - such as seeds, seedlings, tools, and compost.

Summary of Major Activities/Work Projects:

- 1. General COVID-19 Operations** – Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, beginning March 26 all of our staff began working remotely. We are having one staff member go into the office when the mail is available to process document requests, dog licenses and land recording. We are still available to the public by phone and email to answer any questions and help in every possible way. We continue to process voter registrations online, and are catching up on many data entry and cemetery mapping and indexing projects. Our team is staying busy and being as creative as we can to continue to serve the public. We look forward to returning to normalcy and serving our customers face to face.
- 2. Town Meeting Day, Presidential Primary and Representative Town Meeting** – Local elections, Presidential Primary, and Representative Town Meeting were the main focus areas for March. All three districts had to caucus for additional Town Meeting Reps. Due to COVID-19, RTM was canceled by the Selectboard and will be re-warned when appropriate. Currently, District 1 still has seven open seats, and District 3 has one open seat due to the resignation of the incoming Selectboard member.
- 3. Liquor/Entertainment License Renewals** – Renewal liquor and entertainment licenses continue to be processed. All renewals were approved by the Selectboard in February. Due to COVID-19, the DLC has extended the deadline for renewals until June 30, 2020, for any business that has not yet renewed.
- 4. Dog Licenses** – 2020 dog licenses continue to be issued. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, late fees have been waived until further notice. We estimate that we have issued 634 2020 licenses, and there remain approximately 617 unlicensed dogs in town for 2020. Licensing has been slower than normal due to the pandemic.
- 5. Brattleboro Cemetery Committee** – The committee's April meeting to continue the discussion on green burials will be rescheduled for a later date, due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Cemetery records are being computerized.
- 6. Vitals and Land Records** – we are processing these as we are able through mail, email and online payments. Staff is only going into the office when mail is available, so our ability to process these requests are delayed.
- 7.** As time allows, work continues on computerizing cemetery records, digitizing land records and other older town records.
- 8.** Day to day operations continue to operate smoothly.

Re: Departmental Monthly Activity Report – March 2020

Planning Services Department staff began working from home Wednesday, March 18. We are issuing zoning permits that can be handled administratively. Copies of issued zoning permits are posted to the Planning Department webpage. The April DRB meeting was postponed. The Conservation Commission's Earth Day celebration planned for April 25 is cancelled. Staff continues meet the needs of title searchers by providing scans of previously issued permits. One staff person goes into the office weekly to process mail and invoices and search records.

Summary of Major Activities/Work Projects:

- **Land Use Planning**
 - VT Downtown Board awarded Neighborhood Development designation
 - Continuing review of potential zoning changes to address barrier to creating more housing
 - Working on new zoning forms
 - Reviewed a draft plan on the Downtown Design Plan
 - Provided some mapping assistance to the Brattleboro Area Mutual Aid group as they figured out neighborhood boundaries

- **Sustainability**
 - Met with Efficiency Vermont and learned a lot more of the history of the Town re: energy. Identified the lowest the lowest hanging fruit as thermostats and 100% LED building-lighting certifications.
 - Pursuing a weatherization project via the Window Dressers program that Windham and Rockingham are pursuing. Currently working with area energy coordinators to determine how to bring a community workshop to the area, possibly in the fall.
 - Gathering and consolidating historical energy use data.
 - Liaising with community organizers that are organizing mask sewing. Sourced materials for people to put together kits that people could pick up and sew for local hospitals and emergency responders.
 - Trails connection work continues with Friends of the West River, National Park Service, Winston Prouty and Delta Campus

- **Meetings/Conferences**
 - Attended Northern Borders Regional Commission grant workshop
 - Met with DPW and Windham Regional Commission to discuss stormwater needs and potential grant funding
 - Met with community partners to discuss housing issues and barriers and to determine a path forward
 - Planning Technician attended a webinar on Deregulation Trends in Land Use
 - Participated in Windham Economic Response Team meetings
 - Participated in a Community Collective Call early onto hear about what different

- organizations are doing and what they are struggling with
- Zoning Administrator met with Wayne Stires and a local Red Cross rep. to discuss any needed School Crisis plan development aid from Red Cross and materials and response resources available. Group agreed that primary need was for materials and personnel during event.



SUBJ: MARCH 2020 MONTHLY REPORT

Summary of Major Activities/Work Projects:

Officers responded to 571 calls for service/incidents and made 28 arrests resulting in 38 criminal charges. Included in these calls for service were 6 overdoses with 0 resulting in death. This does not mean there were only 6 overdoses in Brattleboro for this period. It merely means that these are the numbers that were responded to by police.

30 vehicle operation citations were issued along with 327 warnings. Officers spent approximately 278 hours on foot patrol in the downtown area as well as other neighborhoods and parks in Town.

Special Meetings/Communications/Events:

Officer's and staff continue to make numerous appearances to meet and discuss the concerns of the citizens at the senior center, elementary schools, with various organizations and community centers. The topics included personal safety, crime trends, homelessness and internet safety. The Brattleboro Police Department continues to make strides in educating and informing the citizens of our activity and to solicit their feedback on how we can improve our services.

There were several meetings held with various neighborhood groups to address the recent surge in larcenies and attempt of larcenies from vehicles. This issue was also addressed several times during the public participation segment of the Select Board meeting. There was also a community forum at the Brooks Memorial Library on 29 February 2020 which was well attended. Represented on the panel were members from the Brattleboro Police Department, Town Government, State's Attorney's office, Restorative Justice State Representatives. The event was very well attended.

Budget Concerns/Impacts:

Monitoring the FY 2020 budget. Preparing to present the FY2021 budget at RTM.

Staffing:

Officer's Busch and Carbone successfully completed all trainings required to become fully certified Brattleboro police officers. Officer Busch is assigned to 1st shift and Officer Carbone to 2nd. We are very excited for these young men to join our ranks and contribute to making our community safe.

The Department currently has 4 openings. A background check is being conducted on 1 applicant to attend the August 2020 110th Vermont Police Academy Basic Class. We are advertising locally and regionally while attending numerous college job fairs throughout New England and New York. The Brattleboro Police Department is continuing to accept applications.

COVID-19

As the Town of Brattleboro responds to COVID-19, the men and women of the Brattleboro Police Department remain steadfast in our commitment to maintain public safety, uphold the law and safeguard the well-being of our community. Our department is working closely with other law enforcement agencies, Dept. of Public Safety, and the State's Attorney Office to help reduce the spread of COVID-19.

As the Town's response to this pandemic evolves, so does BPD's response. In the midst of dealing with COVID-19, law enforcement is one of the jobs that can't be done from home. Here are some of the measures we're taking to protect sworn members, civilian staff and the public from exposure:

There is one specific change that people will notice when they call for medical assistance and that is the question of if they're experiencing flu-like symptoms. The specific reason dispatch is asking that is to make sure that the 1st responders coming to your call are wearing proper equipment. It has no relevance on whether we're coming.

When officers do have to respond in person, they are being encouraged to take steps to limit contact. Officers will ask you to step outside and will avoid going inside your home if possible.

We are now only taking non-emergency reports via phone or online. It is another piece of social distancing we're trying to practice, and we want to make sure we model that with the community that we are doing proper social distancing as well. Our number one priority is and has always been violent crime. For reports of violent crimes and crimes in progress, we will continue to respond to the scene.

Sick employees are instructed to notify their supervisors, stay home and do not come to work.

Members are instructed to wash hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and/or utilize an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.

All external and internal in-service training not related to COVID-19 has been suspended. We are exploring options for video training.

Roll Call is conducted with maximum separation and has even been held outdoors where it's less likely officers will spread the virus to each other.

Public access to the police stations is restricted. If a member of the public needs to meet with an officer, they will be met in front of the building.

We are accepting public records requests through our website; however, the requests will not be completed until our records division is back to work.

To limit face-to-face interactions with the community, we have suspended our in-person community engagement programs.

We are encouraging employees to work remotely when possible. While this isn't possible for patrol officers and many other positions, some employees, such as support staff, are working from home.


All patrol shifts are fully staffed as there has been no change to our schedule.

We are empowered to issue citations for violations of Governor Scott's Executive Order No. 01-20, "Declaration of State of Emergency in Response to COVID-19." However, our approach is to focus on education, rather than enforcement. I have witnessed our citizens doing their part and believe they will continue to do so. The critical goal of this order is to inhibit the spread of Coronavirus. Please remember-our elders and community members with compromised immune systems are most at risk when we do not follow these commonsense health guidelines. It is critical that we all are partners in this process.
